Required Forms & Information:

Building Permit Application Form (dated and signed)

Letter of Authorization from Owner (required if the Applicant not the owner)

Site Plan must be dated and signed

Two (2) sets of drawings showing:

- existing house
- deck
- pool placement
- fencing

Sample Plans are available for a DETACHED & ATTACHED DECKS, & RAILING at sebb.ca/sampleplans.

Please note: if the plans are not created by the owner then they must come from a **BCIN certified designer**, architect, or structural engineer
